"INTERNSHIP PROGRAM STARTED FOR DISABILITY ACT"

Lucknow 17 July : For the first time in the state Internship Program for Disability Act has been started for Law students. The internship program will give overview and create awareness amongst Law students about Disability Act. Till date Law students have no information about the right and privileges for Persons with Disabilities, Mr. V.N.Garg, I.A.S., Commissioner for Persons with Disabilities, U.P. told.
